It serves to emphasize the grain structure intensity thereby enhancing the natural beauty of the wood. Variation of color in the wood can be controlled by applying more or less as required or by reducing oil stain with PureCoat Paint Thinner. It can also be inter mixed to create other conventional color.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Reduction: Use as is. Use PureCoat Paint Thinner if necessary to reduce color tone.

Application: Brush, spray, or wipe with rolled cloth

For maximum paint performance, surface to be painted must be dry and in sound condition, free from loose dirt, dust, oil, grease and other foreign matter.
